



Because we take the time to cultivate good leadership skills, we can see the true benefits of this as a critical part of

the Montessori prepared environment. We continued on with our study of geometry with the introduction of how to find the perimeter of a shape.. When it comes to a circle, we found out that it is not as easy as figuring out the sum of the shapes' sides. To learn how to find a circle's circumference, the students had a lesson on radius and diameter and then went on to be introduced to the concept of Pi .
