As a functional skill, everyone does better with math studies if practice continues over time. To that end, feel free to refresh with your child any math facts that get rusty over the summer. You can have confidence in our math curriculum during the school year because we will spend an hour each day working on math in our classroom. We place a heavy emphasis on this work.
