Lessons This Week

Our lesson in math this week was on the Archimedean solids. These are 13 solid polyhedra that are made up of different regular polygons. The students recorded the shape of the faces and the number of faces, vertices, and edges. Our geometry lesson was about different types of lines and the relationship between lines. Students learned about horizontal, vertical, oblique, parallel, perpendicular, divergent, and convergent lines.

The writing prompt for this week allowed the students to dream of all of the ways they would spend a million dollars. Ideas included buying big houses, fast cars, and video games, and taking care of family.
