**E2 Classroom Activities:** Montessori believed that a child's imagination was integral to his or her development. She saw the ability to imagine things that were not truly present as a higher order thinking skill. Montessori felt strongly about the positive effects of one's ability to imagine and believed imagination to be the foundation of intelligence. Montessori considered that without the power of imagination modern scientific thought would not be possible. In one of her most famous quotes Montessori says, “Our aim therefore is not merely to make the child understand, and still less to force him to memorize, but so to touch his imagination as to enthuse him to his inmost core.”



One of the ways that we do this is through plays. Not fantasy plays, but plays with real elements, as



in historical fiction. Hence our current play, *Dar and the Spearthrower*, a play adapted from Marjorie Crowley's historical fiction book by the same name, is a play about a real time in ancient history, a time when our ancestors were developing some of the first technologies. In creative play, students emulate their characters on the playground by crafting tools and making headdresses of leaves and flowers.

As part of our Grandparents Day we were able to give a preview of the play. Grandparents and special friends were impressed with the children's ability to project their voices, show appropriate emotion, and memorize their lines. We also had a chance to present our portfolios for our audience, giving our visitors a sample of some of the work that is done in our classroom. Our finale was community; we all had a chance to chat informally while we shared a delicious apple spice compote that had been made by the children. What a wonderful time was had by all!
